Dining Dollars add flexibility to your dining options; and are yours to spend like cash at all Dining Services locations. As an additional value, Dining Dollars are tax exempt. Dining Dollars carry over from fall to spring, but end on the last day of the academic calendar and are there after forfeited.



* Take 3, also known as "swaps", is designed as a quick meal on the go from a select menu in the Bistro. Swaps are deducted from your weekly Higgins Café meals. Dining plan participants are welcome to exchange one swap for one meal per meal period in the Bistro until 9pm including the All Access Plan. Please remember that Swaps are for the meal participant only as a convenience and are nontransferable.
